What you will need:

PLACEMAT & COASTER

RED HEART Holiday: 1 ball each 09040 Red/Met. Silver A and 06040 Green/Met. Silver C, 2 balls 00140 White/Met. Silver B
NOTE: Yarn amounts will make a complete set of 4 placemats and 4 coasters, two in each colour combination.

Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8]

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GARLAND

RED HEART Holiday: 1 ball each 09040 Red/Met. Silver A, 06040 Green/Met. Silver B, and 00140 White/Met. Silver C

Crochet Hook: 4mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle, jingle bells

TENSION/GAUGE: 14 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 7 rounds = 10 cm [4"] in treble crochet. **CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the tension/gauge.



RED HEART® Holiday, Art. 9809759 available in 100 g (3.5 oz), 215 m (235 yd) balls.



Pinwheel Place Setting & Garland

Create a special setting for holiday dinners and entertaining! The pinwheel design is fun to crochet and will be enjoyed for years to come. Make the coasters, placemats or garland in other colours to use for any special celebration.

Placemat measures 40 cm [16"] in diameter.
Coaster measure 11 cm [4½"] in diameter.
Garland measures 82.5 cm [32½"] long.

NOTE

Make 2 settings with **A** and **B** and 2 with **C** and **B**. Rounds of Placemat will be worked with 2 colours. Drop first colour, drawing a long loop to keep sts from unraveling, to be picked up next time you are ready to use that colour.

PLACEMAT

Center

With **A (C)**, ch 4; join with a slip st in first ch to form a ring; ch 1, (dc, htr, 3 tr) all into ring, drop **A (C)**, pulling a long loop, DO NOT FASTEN OFF; following the **A (C)** sts, join **B** with dc in ring, work (htr, 3 tr) all in same ring, drop **B**, DO NOT FASTEN OFF.

Round 1: Pick up **A (C)**, work 2 tr in each **B** st – 10 tr, drop **A (C)**, pick up **B**, work 2 tr in each **A (C)** st around – 30 **B** sts, drop **B**.

Round 2: Pick up **A (C)**, *tr in next tr, 2 tr in next tr; repeat from * around – 45 tr **A (C)**; drop **A (C)**, pick up **B** and repeat from * to last st; tr in last st – 67 tr **B**, drop **B**.

Round 3: Pick up **A (C)**, [tr in next 3 tr, 2 tr in next tr] 16 times, tr in last 3 tr – 83 tr **A**; drop **A (C)**, pick up **B**, [tr in next 6 tr, 2 tr in next tr] 11 times, tr in last 6 tr – 94 tr **B**, drop **B**.

Round 4: Pick up **A (C)**, [tr in next 10 tr, 2 tr in next tr] 8 times, tr in next 6 tr – 102 tr **A (C)**; drop **A (C)**, pick up **B**, [tr in next 6 tr, 2 tr in next tr] 14 times, tr in last 4 tr – 116 tr **B**, drop **B**.

Round 5: Pick up **A (C)**, [tr in next 10 tr, 2 tr in next tr] 10 times, tr in next 6 tr – 126 tr **A (C)**; drop **A (C)**, pick up **B**, [tr in next 10 tr, 2 tr in next tr] 11 times, tr in last 5 tr – 137 tr **B**, drop **B**.

Round 6: Pick up **A (C)**, [tr in next 14 tr, 2 tr in next tr] 9 times, tr in next 2 tr – 146 tr **A (C)**; drop **A (C)**, pick up **B**, [tr in next 18 tr, 2 tr

in next tr] 7 times, tr in last 13 tr – 153 tr **B**. Mark 77th tr from hook.

Round 7: Pick up **A (C)**, *tr in next 18 tr, 2 tr in next tr; repeat from * to marker; **htr in next 2 tr, dc in next tr, slip st in next tr **; fasten off **A (C)**; pick up **B**; repeat from ** to ** across next 4 tr. Fasten off **B**.

COASTER

Work same as Placemat through Round 1.

Round 2: Pick up **A (C)**, 2 tr in next 10 tr, tr in next tr, *htr in next tr, dc in next tr, slip st in next tr *; fasten off **A (C)**, pick up **B**, tr in next tr; repeat from * to * across next 3 tr. Fasten off **B**.

FINISHING

Border

Worked on Placemats and Coasters

With right side facing, join **C** in any st, ch 1, *(dc, ch 2, dc) all in same st, skip next st; repeat from * around; join with a slip st in first dc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

GARLAND

Center

With **A**, ch 4; join with a slip st in first ch to form a ring; ch 1, (dc, 4 htr) all into ring, drop **A**, DO NOT FASTEN OFF; following the **A** sts, join **B** with an dc in the ring, work 4 htr into same ring, drop **B**, DO NOT FASTEN OFF.

Round 1: Pick up **A**, work 2 htr into each **B** st – 10 htr **A**; drop **A**, pick up **B**, work 2 htr in each **A** st – 30 htr **B**, drop **B**.

Round 2: Pick up **A**, 2 tr in next 10 htr, htr in next htr, *htr in next htr, dc in next htr, slip st in next htr, ch 5 *; fasten off **A**, leaving a long end to sew loop; pick up **B**, 2 htr in next htr; repeat from * to * across next 3 htr; fasten off **B**, leaving a long end to sew loop.

Please Note: Print this pattern using Landscape Orientation.

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Make 9 more pieces with your choice of **A+C**, **B+C**, or **A+B**.

Connecting Garland Pieces

First Piece: Thread yarn needle with long end left after ch-5 and stitch into coaster near beginning of the chain to make a loop; secure yarn on wrong side. Repeat on opposite side of coaster.

Join 2nd Piece: Thread yarn needle with long end left after ch-5 of 2nd piece, weave through a finished loop, stitch into coaster near beginning of this chain; secure yarn. Complete a loop on opposite side of coaster. Continue until all pieces are joined. Additional pieces can be added to make garland longer if desired.

Jingle Bell Fringe

Thread three bells onto **A**; ch 1, pull first bell up to first ch, make a ch over bell, continue to ch for total of 33 cm [13"], pull 2nd bell up, ch 3, pull 3rd bell up, ch 2. Fasten off. Tie in bow around joining loops.

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

A, B, C = Colour A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **htr** = half treble crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = triple or treble crochet; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.



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
