What you will need:

Red Heart® Niki: 4 (5, 5, 6) balls
02029 Nature

Knitting Needles: 3.75mm [US 5]
and 4.5 mm [US 7]

Circular Knitting Needles: One set
4.5mm [US 7], 40cm [16"] long

Six 19mm [¾"] buttons, two stitch
holders, stitch markers, cable
needle, yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 24 sts = 10
cm [4"]; 28 rows = 10 cm [4"] in
Pattern stitch with larger needle.

CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE.
Use any size needle to obtain the
tension/gauge.

Clever Cabled Cardigan

This classic cabled cardigan will never go out of style. Knit it in a neutral colour as shown here and it will be worn with everything in your child's wardrobe.

Directions are for size 2 years; changes for sizes 4, 6 and 8 years are in parentheses.

Finished Chest: 56 (61, 66, 71) cm [22 (24, 26, 28)"]

Finished length: 30.5 (33, 35.5, 38) cm [12 (13, 14, 15)"]

Special Abbreviations

2/2 RC Slip 2 sts to cable needle, hold to back, k2; k2 from cable needle.

2/2 LC Slip 2 sts to cable needle, hold to front, k2; k2 from cable needle.

PATTERN STITCHES

Cable Pattern (multiple of 12 stitches)

Row 1 (RS): * P2, k8, p2; repeat from *.

Rows 2, 4: * K2, p8, k2; repeat from *.

Row 3: * P2, 2/2 RC, 2/2 LC, p2; repeat from *.
Repeat these 4 rows for Cable Pattern.

1 x 1 Rib (multiple of 2 sts + 1)

Row 1 (Right Side): *K1, p1; repeat from * to last st, k1.

Row 2: *P1, k1; repeat from * to last st, p1.
Repeat these 2 rows for 1 x 1 Rib.

Notes

- Sweater is worked flat in one piece from bottom to underarms. Piece is then divided and fronts and back worked separately.
- Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of stitches in Body.

LOWER BODY

With circular needle cast on 132 (144, 156, 168) sts. Do not join; work flat back and forth. Knit 4 rows.

Work Cable Pattern until piece measures 18 (19, 20.5, 20.5) cm [7 (7½, 8, 8)"], end with a wrong side row.

Divide fronts and back

Next row (Right Side): Continuing in pattern, work 28 (30, 32, 34) sts for Right Front, cast off 10 (12, 14, 16) sts for right underarm, work 56 (60, 64, 68) sts for Back, cast off 10 (12, 14, 16) sts for left underarm, work 28 (30, 32, 34) sts for Left Front. Place stitches for Right Front and Back on stitch holders.

LEFT FRONT

Continue Cable Pattern until piece measures 9 (10, 10, 12.5) cm [3½ (4, 4, 5)"] from armhole cast off, end with a right side row.

Shape Neck

Next row (Wrong Side): Cast off 12 (12, 14, 14) sts, work to end – 16 (18, 18, 20) sts. Work even until piece measures 30.5 (33, 35.5, 38) cm [12 (13, 14, 15)"] from beginning. Cast off.

BACK

Slip Back stitches to needle. With wrong side facing, continue Cable Pattern until piece measures 30.5 (33, 35.5, 38) cm [12 (13, 14, 15)"] from beginning. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

Slip Right Front stitches to needle. With wrong side facing, continue Cable Pattern until piece measures 9 (10, 10, 12.5) cm [3½ (4, 4, 5)"] from armhole cast off, end with a wrong side row.

Shape Neck

Next row (Right Side): Cast off 12 (12, 14, 14) sts, work to end – 16 (18, 18, 20) sts. Work even until piece measures 30.5 (33, 35.5, 38) cm [12 (13, 14, 15)"] from beginning. Cast off.

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SLEEVES (Make 2)

With smaller needles cast on 40

(45, 48, 61) sts.

Work 1 x 1 Rib for 2.5 cm [1"], increasing 2 (3, 4, 3) sts on last wrong side row – 42 (48, 52, 64) sts. Change to larger needles.

Next row (Right Side): P3 (0, 2, 2), place marker, work in Cable Pattern to last 3 (0, 2, 2) sts, place marker, purl to end.

Next row (Wrong Side): K3 (0, 2, 2), slip marker, work in Cable Pattern to last 3 (0, 2, 2) sts, slip marker, knit to end.

Repeat last 2 rows once.

Increase row (Right Side): Inc; work in established patterns before, between and after markers to last st; inc – 44 (50, 54, 66) sts. Repeat Increase Row every 4th row 4 more times, then every 6th row 5 times – 62 (68, 72, 84) sts.

Work even until sleeve measures 21.5 (26.5, 29, 32) cm [8½ (10½, 11½, 12½)] from beginning. Cast off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends; block pieces.

Sew shoulder seams.

Neckband

With smaller needles and right side facing, pick up and knit 61 (61, 71, 71) sts around neck. Work 1 x 1 Rib for 2.5 cm [1"]; cast off in pattern.

Button Band

With smaller needle and right side facing, pick up and knit 52 (56, 60, 64) sts along Left Front. Knit 6 rows. Cast off.

Buttonhole Band

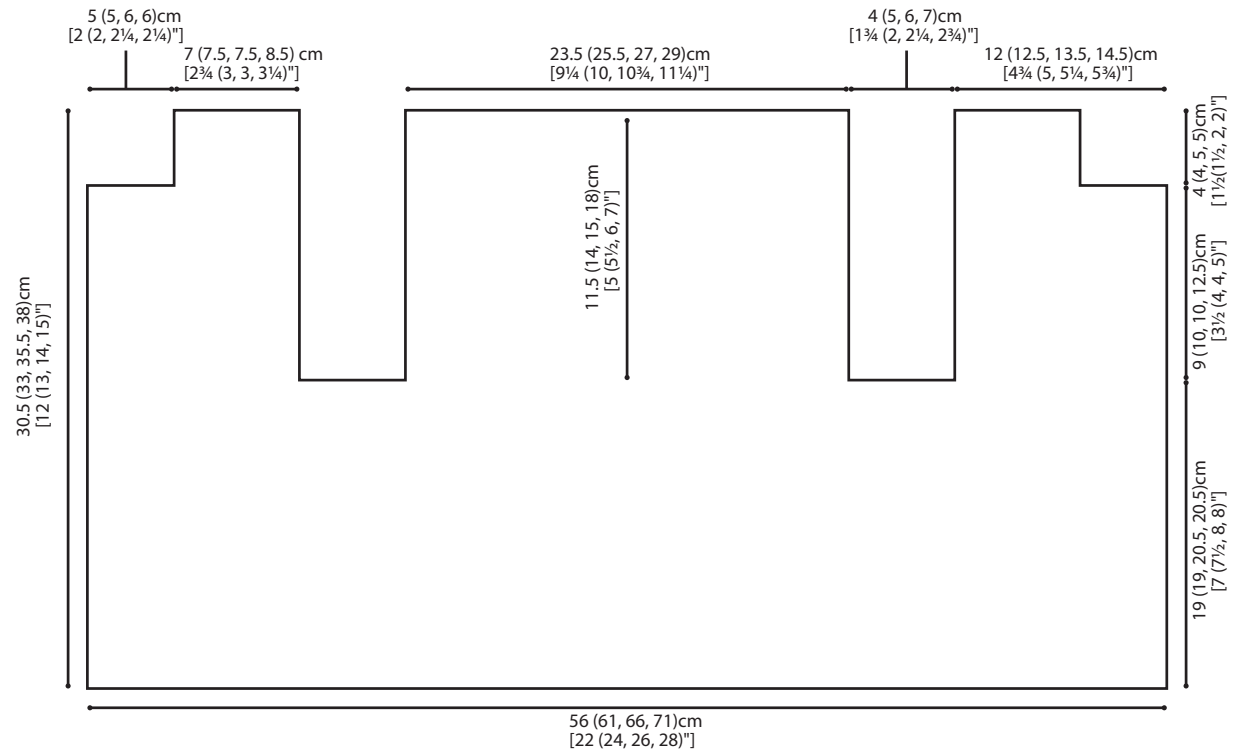
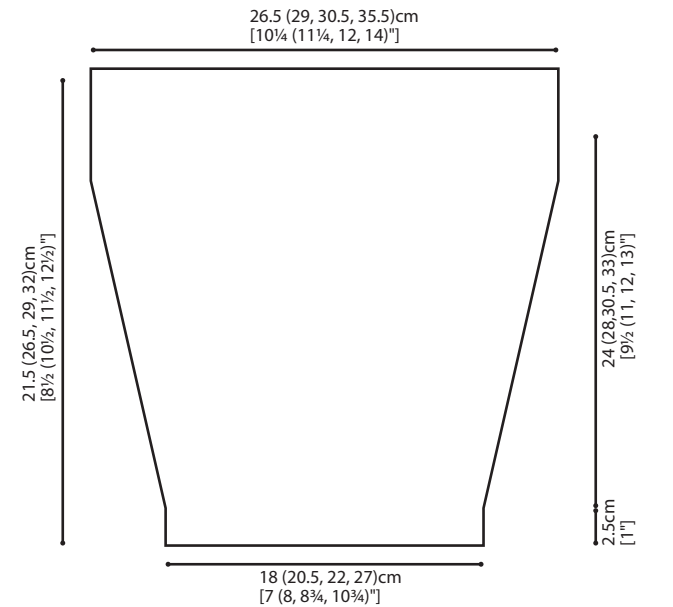
With smaller needle and right side facing, pick up and knit 52 (56, 60, 64) sts along Right Front. Knit 3 rows.

Buttonhole row (Right Side): K3, [yo, k2tog, k6 (7, 8, 9)] 5 times, yo, k2tog, k3 (3, 4, 5) sts. Knit 2 rows. Cast off.

Sew sleeve seams; sew sleeves in armhole. Sew buttons opposite buttonholes.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **St st** = Stockinette stitch; **k2tog** = knit next 2 stitches together; **inc** = increase 1 stitch; **yo** = yarn over; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.



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
