### What you will need:

RED HEART® Detroit: 1 (2, 2, 2) balls  
OR  
RED HEART® Lisa: 2, (4, 4, 4,) balls

Crochet Hook: 3.5mm [US 4-E]

4 (5, 5, 6) buttons, 13mm [½"], yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 20 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 12 rows = 12 cm [4"] in yoke pattern stitch; 10 rows = 12 cm [4"] in lower pattern stitch. **CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the tension/gauge.

## Cosy Baby Cardigan

*Crochet a simple cardigan for baby to wear every day! This unisex design is perfect for both girl and boy babies.*

Directions are for size 6 months; changes for sizes 12, 18 and 24 months are in parentheses.

**Chest:** 42 (46, 50, 55) cm [16½ (18, 19½, 21½)"], buttoned

**Length:** 23 (28, 31, 35) cm [9 (10¾, 12, 13¾)"]

### NOTE

- Sweater is worked in one piece from neck down to armholes. Piece is then separated into Fronts, Back and Sleeves and worked to lower edges.
- Yoke pattern stitch is worked with one row of double crochet then one row of treble crochet, working in both loops of all sts. Lower pattern stitch is worked with one row of half treble crochet then one row of treble crochet, working in back loop of all sts.
- Beginning ch do not count as a stitch throughout.

### SWEATER

#### Yoke

Ch 45.

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in each st around; turn – 44 sts,

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st throughout), tr in first st, tr in next 5 sts for Left Front, (tr, ch 1, tr) in next st for Raglan seam, place marker in ch-1 space, tr in next 6 sts for Sleeve, (tr, ch 1, tr), in next st for Raglan seam, place marker in ch-1 space, tr in next 16 sts for Back, (tr, ch 1, tr), in next st for Raglan seam, place marker in ch-1 space, tr in next 6 sts for Sleeve, (tr, ch 1, tr), in next st for Raglan seam, place marker in ch-1 space, tr in last 6 sts for Right Front; turn – 48 tr and 4 ch-1 spaces.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in next 6 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-1 space, dc in next 8 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-1 space, dc in next 18 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-1 space, dc in next 8 dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-1 space, dc in last 7 sts – 56 dc and 4 ch-2 spaces.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, tr in first st, \*tr in each st to next ch-2 space, (tr, ch 1, tr) in ch-2 space; repeat from \* around; turn – 64 tr and 4 ch-1 spaces.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, dc in first st, \*dc in each st to next ch-1 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-1 space; repeat from \* around; turn – 72 dc and 4 ch-2 spaces.

**Rows 6-13 (15, 17, 19):** Repeat Rows 4 and 5 – 136 (152, 168, 184) dc and 4 ch-1 spaces on last row worked. Fasten off.

### Right Front

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** With wrong side facing, join yarn in first st at front edge, dc in same space, dc in each st across to next ch-2 space, dc in next ch-2 space; turn – 19 (21, 23, 25) dc. Leave remaining sts unworked.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, working in back loops only, tr in first st, tr in each st across; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, working in back loops only, htr in first st, htr in each st across; turn.

**Rows 4-13 (15, 17, 19):** Repeat Rows 2-3.

**Row 14 (16, 18, 20):** Ch 1, working in back loops only, dc in same st, dc in each st across. Fasten off.

### Back

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** With wrong side facing, join yarn in second ch-2 space along last long row worked, dc in same space, dc in each st across to next ch-2 space, dc in next ch-2 space; turn – 42 (46, 50, 54) dc.

Please Note: Print this pattern using Landscape Orientation.

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**Row 2:** Ch 2, working in back loops only, tr in first st, tr in each st across; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, working in back loops only, htr in first st, htr in each st across; turn.

**Rows 4-13 (15, 17, 19):** Repeat Rows 2-3.

**Row 14 (16, 18, 20):** Ch 1, working in back loops only, dc in same st, dc in each st across. Fasten off.

### Left Front

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** With wrong side facing, join yarn in last ch-2 space along last long row worked, dc in same space, dc in each st across to end of row; turn – 19 (21, 23, 25) dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, working in back loops only, tr in first st, tr in each st across; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, working in back loops only, htr in first st, htr in each st across; turn.

**Rows 4-13 (15, 17, 19):** Repeat Rows 2-3.

**Row 14 (16, 18, 20):** Ch 1, working in back loops only, dc in same st, dc in each st across. Fasten off.

### Right Sleeve

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** With wrong side facing, join yarn in first ch-2 space, dc in same space, dc in each st across to next ch-2 space, dc in next ch-2 space; turn – 32 (36, 40, 44) dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, working in back loops only, tr in first st, tr in each st across; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, working in back loops only, htr in first st, htr in each st across; turn.

**Rows 4-15 (17, 19, 21):** Repeat Rows 2-3.

**Row 15 (18, 20, 22):** Ch 1, working in back loops only, dc in same st, dc in each st across. Fasten off.

### Left Sleeve

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** With wrong side facing, join yarn in 3rd ch-2 space, dc in same space, dc in each st across to next ch-2 space, dc in next ch-2 space; turn – 32 (36, 40, 44) dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, working in back loops only, tr in first st, tr in each st across; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, working in back loops only, htr in first st, htr in each st across; turn.

**Rows 4-15 (17, 19, 21):** Repeat Rows 2-3.

**Row 15 (18, 20, 22):** Ch 1, working in back loops only, dc in same st, dc in each st across. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew side and Sleeve seams.

### Collar

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** With wrong side facing, join yarn at front neck edge, ch 2, tr 40 (44, 44, 44) sts evenly spaced around neck to opposite front neck edge; turn – 40 (44, 44, 44) tr.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, 2 dc in first st, dc in each st across to last st, increasing 3 sts evenly spaced, 2 dc in last st; turn – 45 (49, 49, 49) dc.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, tr in first st, htr in each st across; turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, 2 dc in first st, dc in each st across to last st, increasing 6 sts evenly spaced, 2 dc in last st; turn – 53 (57, 57, 57) dc.

**Row 5:** Repeat Row 3. Fasten off.

**Border Row:** With right side facing, join yarn at neck edge, dc in same st, dc 7 sts along edges of row to last row, turn to work along last row of Collar, dc in each st across, turn to work along edge of rows, dc 8 sts along edges of row. Fasten off.

**Note:** Instructions that follow are for right over left button closure. If left over right buttoning is desired, do the edgings on opposite front edges.

### Button Edging

**Row 1 (Right Side):** With right side facing, join yarn at neck edge of Left Front, ch 1, dc in same st, dc 35 (41, 46, 51) sts evenly spaced to lower edge; turn – 36 (42, 47, 52) sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, tr in first st, tr in each st across; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, dc in first st, dc in each st across. Fasten off.

Mark for 4 (5, 5, 6) buttons evenly space along Button Edging with first at neck edge and last 5 cm [2"] from lower edge.

### Buttonhole Edging

**Row 1 (Right Side):** With right side facing, join yarn at lower edge of Right Front, ch 1, dc in same st, dc 35 (41, 46, 51) sts evenly spaced to neck edge; turn – 36 (42, 47, 52) sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, tr in first st, tr in each st across, working (ch 1, skip next st) where marked for each button; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch1, dc in first st, dc in each tr and ch-1 space across. Fasten off.

Sew buttons opposite buttonholes.

Weave in ends

## Abbreviations

**ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **htr** = half treble crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = triple or treble crochet; **\*** or **\*\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.

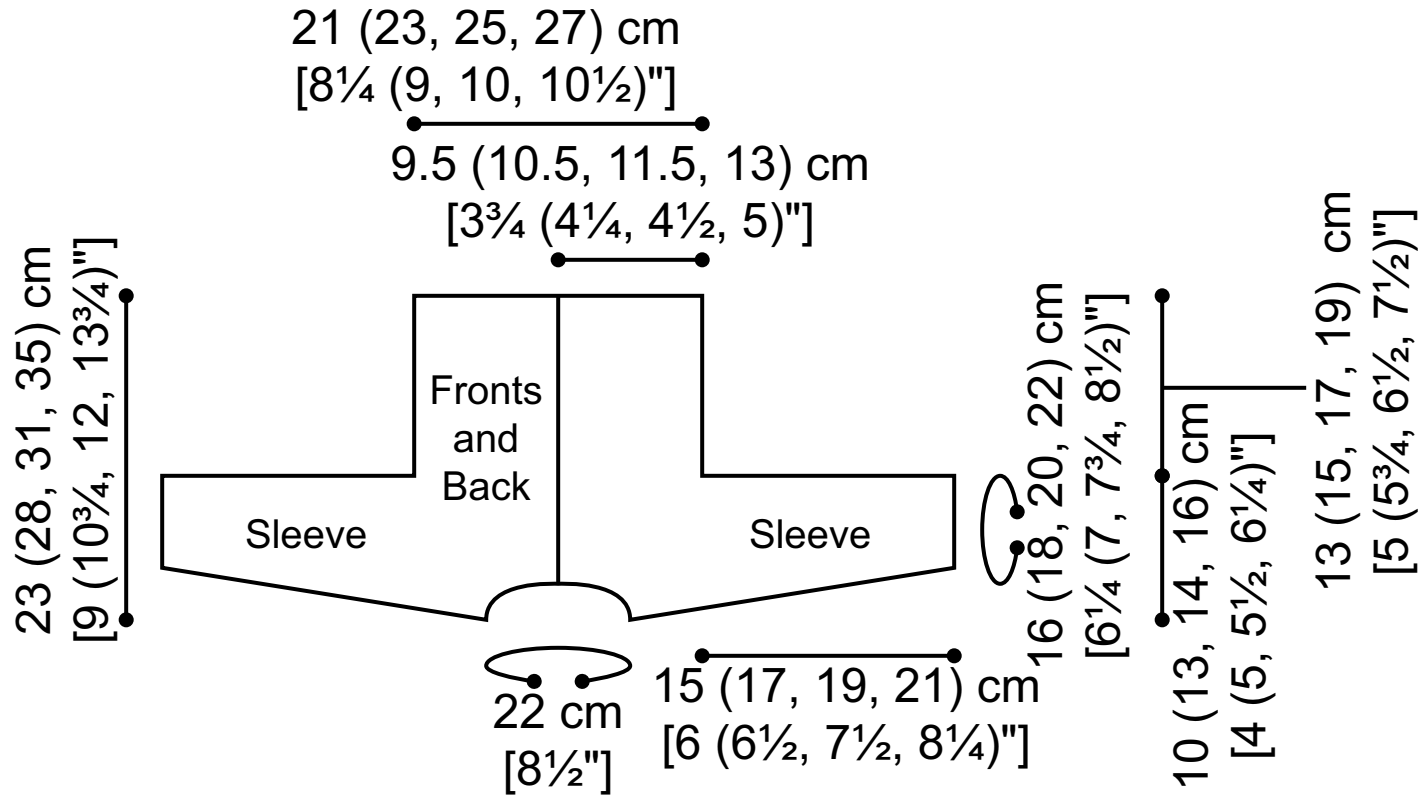
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
